*WS score: 95* "Full-bodied, with soft and silky tannins and a long, long finish. Intense and balanced."
- Brunello di Montalcino** 2006 Castelgiocondo, Montalcino 115  
*Winery Notes:* "The 2006 exhibits layered aromas of wild blackberry, red currant and sour cherry, closely followed by floral notes of sweet violets and spicy characters of black pepper, clove and tobacco leaf. Cocoa, roasted espresso bean, vanilla and a slight mineral character add to the complexity of the nose. Fruit-driven flavours dominate the long finish."
- Brunello di Montalcino** 2004 La Fortuna, Montalcino 119  
*WS:* "Rose and cherry aromas follow through to a medium body, with firm tannins and fresh acidity."
- Brunello di Montalcino** 2006 Altesino, Montalcino 110  
*WS score: 91* "Smells like Red Burgundy, with floral, cherry, woody and graphite aromas and flavours. Sweet and silky, underscored by firm, integrated tannins. Distinctive and delicious."
- Brunello di Montalcino** 2004 Valdicava, Vincenzo Abbruzzese, Montalcino 270  
*WA score: 94* "The 2004 Brunello di Montalcino is simply beautiful. Firm but silky tannins. Smoke, cured meats, earthiness and graphite develop in the glass, adding further complexity. Sweet roses and spices linger on the long, refined finish."
- Brunello di Montalcino** 2005 Valdicava, Vincenzo Abbruzzese, Montalcino 220  
*WS score: 91* "The 2005 Brunello di Montalcino is a brooding wine that flows with the essence of smoke, tar, earthiness, wild cherries and iron. This is one of the richest, concentrated Brunellos of the vintage."
- Brunello di Montalcino** 2006 Collemattoni, Montalcino 135  
*WS score: 91* "Delivers a mix of cherry, raspberry and cocoa aromas and flavours, picking up spice and tobacco elements on the finish. This is open and inviting, tightening up on the finish."
- Brunello di Montalcino** 2004/2005 Armilla 120  
*Winery Notes:* Dark blackcherry colour indicating the ripeness of the vintage. Nose is expressive and big with cherry and notes of licorice and dates. Mouthcoatingly smooth and with more ripe cherry, toast and mineral on the palate, long finish. The balance of the fruit, alcohol, oak and acidity work perfectly together. The tannins are ripe, but firm."
- Brunello di Montalcino Riserva "Vigna Paganelli"** 2006 Il Poggione, Montalcino 170  
*Tasting Notes:* "Very intense, lingering and stylish bouquet with red and dark berry fruit notes. Warm, balanced flavour with velvet-smooth tannins and long-lasting finish. "

The 2007 is not a big, massive Ornellaia, but rather a wine built on elegance and finesse, both which are on display. The 2007 Ornellaia is 55% Cabernet Sauvignon, 27% Merlot, 14% Cabernet Franc and 4% Petit Verdot."*

**Sassicaia** 2008 Tenuta San Guido Bolgheri 260

*WS score: 94 "Refined and elegant, this is right in step with the reserve of the vintage. Blackberry, plum, cassis and mineral flavors play out with subtle oak spice notes on the finish, where this flexes some muscle. 85% Cabernet Sauvignon and 15% Cabernet Franc."*
